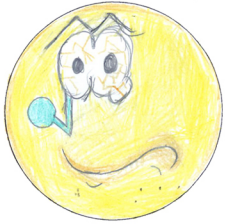
TRAVEL

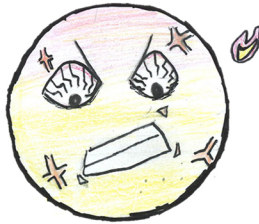
